### *G4S Events – Who are we?*

G4S Events is the leading provider of crowd management, stewarding and security staff to the UK events market. We are an expanding business with stewarding contracts at a broad range of live music concerts and festivals, sporting events, exhibitions, conferences and outdoor events. G4S is currently looking for smart, reliable staff that enjoy dealing with the general public to join our stewarding teams across the UK.

### *Why work for G4S Events?*

G4S Events is recruiting part time event stewards to work at a number of high profile events. The roles available involve evening and weekend work and can therefore compliment an existing full time job or provide the opportunity to gain additional employment. No specialist experience is required as full training will be given. Once employed by G4S Events, employees will be supported to achieve their NCFE event stewarding level 2 qualification and be given the opportunity to gain an SIA licence.

No two days are the same and duties are varied but can include car park stewarding, checking tickets, offering advice and information to the public and VIP stewarding.

### *Where might stewards work?*

G4S has offices in London and the South East, Manchester, Sheffield, Edinburgh and Glasgow but supplies stewards to events all over the country. High-profile events covered by G4S in 2008 included V festival, T in the park, The Tutankhamen Exhibition at the O2, England v New Zealand 2<sup>nd</sup> Test Match at Old Trafford Cricket Ground, Manchester, the Conservative and Labour party conferences, the Championships, Wimbledon, the Epsom Downs Derby Festival and the golfing Open Championships. On one weekend, G4S covered the Scottish FA Cup Final at Hampden Park, Glasgow; the Kaiser Chiefs concert at Elland Road Stadium, Leeds and The Osmonds and Westlife concerts in Sheffield. Stewarding at football matches and other sporting fixtures on a year round basis can also form part of the role.

### *What is involved?*

A positive, open minded approach to work is essential to the role as is flexibility and a willingness to participate in a range of events. Staff are all enrolled on the NCFE training scheme in event stewarding with an option to obtain an SIA license. In order to be considered, candidates should contact us using the information below to receive an application form. If successful, candidates will be asked to visit us at one of our local offices for a company presentation and interview.

Candidates considering applying for a role must be able to meet the following criteria:

Candidates must:

- Have the right to work in the UK
- Be able to provide two forms of photographic identity including proof of address
- Have no criminal convictions
- Be able to supply two personal references (not necessarily from their existing employer)
- Be over 18 years of age
